SPECIAL INFORMATION:

1. Max Flight Times and Fly-off Rules will be contained in a schedule provided to each contestant and will be basically in accord with appropriate rule books and subject to wind conditions.
2. The America's Cup Competition: 1st Round 0800 each day.
3. @ These are National Cup Events. Only the first model flown will be considered for the local trophy, and all basic flights for that model must be completed the day started. Times for the first model will be recorded for National Cup points. Other models in the combo may be flown for National Cup points on either day.
4. Flights started on Saturday must be completed on Saturday. Contestants completing three-max basic flights on Saturday may compete in flyoffs on Sunday
5. @@ FAC Eligibility Rules differ from SAM Rules only in that Windshields are required for FAC OTR. If a FAC eligible model achieves first place, it will be awarded a Kanone.
6. All Model aircraft flown in AMA events must conform to AMA identification requirements.
AMA Card must be presented at registration
7. Flight times and **name of model** will be recorded with the C/D after each flight except for CAT/HL Glider
8. Builder of Model Rule applies to all except FAI events.
9. @@@ Max rubber for launch is 9" X 1/4" loop (may be 2 strands of 1/8")
10. All AMA events are Category III

Flying Site: A copy of the official entry form is attached. The instructions for reaching the field are on the entry form.

Registration: Registration will take place at the field commencing at 0800 Saturday morning.

Motel Accommodations: There are 8 motels about 3 miles from the field, all at I-10 and Exit 7. The prices and quality of the motels vary from excellent to basic. The **Leisure Lake RV Park** is on your left. The RV park is on a lake and fishing is free. The RV park is 1/2 mile west of the gate to the field. The phone number is 850-941-4030. .

FAC Event Info: All FAC judging will be done on the field. SAM Commercial Rubber and FAC Old Time Rubber will be combined, with the first-place winner earning an FAC Kanone if the model meets FAC requirements. Two-Bit Rubber will be ROG.

National Cup Events: The following AMA and NFFS events will be held for National Cup point accumulation:

AMA101,102,103,104,105,101C,102-103C,104-105C,120,124,128,140,142,NOSGAS-1/4A,NOSGAS-1/2A,NOSGAS-A, NOSGAS-B, NOSGAS-C. **Please note that events 102 and 103,104 and 105, NOS 1/4A,1/2A and Early 1/2A Gas, as well as NOS A, B and C will be flown combined for single sets of awards locally, but scores will be kept separately for each category for NC reporting.**

SAM Rubber: The traditional favorites, SAM **Small and Large stick** will be combined as will **Small and Large fuselage**. **Commercial rubber** will be combined with FAC Old Time Rubber Cabin for one award.
